RESPONSIBILITIES

The ideal candidate will be responsible for teaching Intro to Photography course(s). Primarily a studio course covering the camera, film developing, print enlargement, basic digital photography and developing photographic design. The course is designed for non-majors and students with a limited background.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Master's degree (MFA or MA) in photography or closely related field required.
- 2 years of College-level teaching experience in photography preferred with strong portfolio in photography or related field.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

General environment requires employee to be flexible. This work may include hours standing and walking, including up and down stairs, moving items of up to 25-pounds. Evening and weekend hours may be needed, on occasion, to perform work associated with this position.

Applicants should include 1) cover letter; 2) curriculum vitae; 3) 5-7 samples of scholarly or creative work, and 5-7 samples of student creative work; link to online portfolio is acceptable; 4) statement of teaching philosophy; 5) evidence of teaching effectiveness (i.e. student evaluations of teaching, sample syllabi of courses taught) and 6) minimum of three references.
